Chickpeas



Chickpeas are edible legumes belonging to the family of 'Fabaceae' with slightly round & irregular shape, and are slightly longer in size than the normal peas. They are also known by the names of 'garbanzo beans', and have a nut like taste with a high protein content in them.

Cumin-Seeds



Cumin, also known as 'jeera' in India, is a widely used ingredient in Indian cuisines. It is referred to as the dried seed of 'Cuminum cyminum' that belongs to the parsley family. Cumin seeds are derived from the plant of cumin, a herbaceous annual plant, that has slender branched stems about 30 cm tall.

Coriander



Coriander, also known as the Chinese Parsley, Cilantro, Dizzycorn and Japanese Parsley, is an annual herb in the family Apiaceae. It is among the the first spices used by mankind, having been known as early as 5000 BC. Its description is also mentioned in Sanskrit writings dating from about 1500 BC.

Wheat



Wheat is defined as a cultivated grass which is grown primarily for its nutritional grains. It grows anywhere between 2 and 4 feet. The scientific name of wheat is 'Gramineae' and belong to the genus 'Triticum'.

Sesame seeds



Sesame seeds or benny seed or benne seed can be described as tiny oval seeds that are flat in their structure and have a nutty taste as well as a delicate crunch. They are the most common forms of seeds produced in the world.

Fennel Seeds



Fennel seeds are defined as the dried yellowish brown schizocarpic fruits that are obtained from the plant of fennel, a perennial herb in the genus 'Foeniculum'. These seeds are about 10 cm long and about 4 mm wide.

Groundnut

Fenugreek Seeds



Fenugreek, commonly known as Methi in Hindi, is a plant in the family Fabaceae. The seeds of a leguminous plant eaten as a vegetable. The seeds are used as a condiment or seasoning. The flavors of these seeds are mildly bitter and at the same time are slightly sweet.

Carom



Ajwain, ajowan or Trachyspermum ammi —also known as ajowan caraway, bishop's weed, or carom is an annual herb in the family Apiaceae (or Umbelliferae). Both the leaves and the seed like fruit (often mistakenly called seeds) of the plant.

Soyabean



The soybean or soya bean (*Glycine max*) is a species of legume native to East Asia, widely grown for its edible bean, which has numerous uses. Traditional unfermented food uses of soybeans include soy milk, from which tofu and tofu skin are made.

Mustard Seeds



Derived from the many varieties of mustard plants, mustard seeds are very small seeds, about 2 mm in diameter, and seen in colors ranging from yellowish white to black. They are one of the most important ingredients used in many regional cuisines across the world, especially in the Indian sub-continent.
